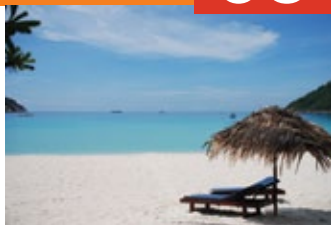

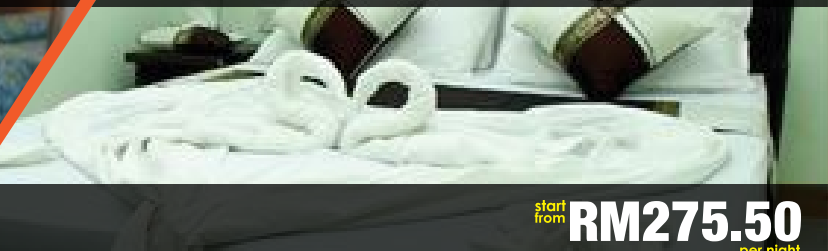

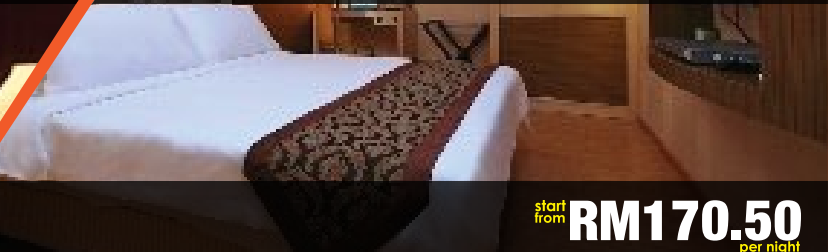

THE ISLAND FOR EVERYONE, LANGKAWI ISLAND

Langkawi is not only geared towards tourism. Many of the islanders are farmers, fishermen and entrepreneurs. Experience the beautiful countryside and the peaceful landscape of paddy fields by renting a car and taking a leisurely drive around the island. Some of Langkawi's most rustic and memorable views are along the road that circles the island. You'll pass small villages with wooden houses framed by palm trees, and children pedalling their old bicycles on an errand. Aside from experiencing the local lifestyle, there is no shortage of things to do in Langkawi. Head up the thrilling new cable car to the summit of Mount Mat Cincang - Langkawi's second highest mountain - for an unrivalled view of the entire main island and beyond. You can also visit the Field of Burnt Rice, the Hot Springs, Telaga Tujuh (The Seven Wells) and the Beach of Black Sand. Boat tours are organised to Tasik Dayang Bunting, (Lake of the Pregnant Maiden), Gua Cerita (Cave of Stories) and the Gua Langsir (Curtain Cave). And if you're more outdoorsy, why not go trekking through the pristine rainforest that blankets most of Langkawi, or go on a boat tour of the mangroves, go diving, or play a round of golf at some of the 5-star resorts. Langkawi also has an underwater world, containing an underground tunnel that runs through a giant aquarium, that has gotten rave reviews. For beautiful scenery, great adventures and five-star conveniences, Langkawi is the place to getaway.

THE TREASURE OF PULAU TIOMAN

Pulau Tioman belongs to the state of Pahang. A lot of people including Malaysians always mistaken that this island belongs to Johor due to the gateway jetty is in Mersing. Mersing is located in the state of Johor. Pulau Tioman : (Tioman Island) is the largest in the a group of 64 volcanic islands which includes Pulau Sei Buat, Pulau Sembilang, Pulau Tulai , Pulau Chebeh , Pulau Labas and Pulau Renggis is located 80km northwest off Peninsular Malaysia's east coast. According to a local folklore

this island is the resting place of a fabled dragon princess who had turned herself into an island in the South China Sea and become truly one of the most beautiful islands in the region. Blessed with milies and miles of soft white sand, swaying palms , wild flowers growing in vivid profusion and cool waterfalls cascading down green slopes,

Pulau Tioman is an adventurer's paradise for quite retreats, trekking, sunbathing and sea sports. Tioman Island is a treasure trove of breathtaking marine attractions. Corals, seashells and limpets, thorny sea urchins, colourful seaweeds and anemones, starfish and a myriad of other aquatic wonders are abundant here. The crystal clear waters make scuba diving and snorkelling in Tioman an experience unlike any other. Other neighbouring islands recommended for scuba diving and snorkelling are Chebeh, Tulai, Renggis, Sembilang, Seri Buat and Gut. When the stress of life's hectic pace gets to you, rejuvenate your mind and body at Tioman Island. Immerse yourself in the quiet and tranquil setting. Relax to the cool, refreshing breeze and soothing waves. Bask in the tropical sun or walk along the shores during sunset to experience the beauty of the island. Popular beaches are found around the villages of Tekek, Genting, Salang, Air Batang and Juara. For golf-lovers, tee off at the 18-hole international-standard golf course set amidst lush tropical greenery. Enjoy the picturesque sight of rustic villages scattered around the island, where the people are charming, friendly and gracious.

ISLAND HAVEN, REDANG ISLAND

Pulau Redang in Malaysia is a popular tourist destination. It is located 45km off the coast of Kuala Terengganu and is the largest of a group of nine protected islands dotting the South China Sea off the Terengganu coast. The islands boast of clear waters and a number of dive sites for diving enthusiasts. The island is sheltered within the Pulau Redang Marine Park. The waters here are very rich in marine life. You can see brilliant hues of coral, anemones

and fish at midday when the sun penetrates the sea. The waters around Pulau Redang are known for two historic shipwrecks. H.M.S. Prince of Wales and H.M.S. Repulse had sunk here during the start of the Second World War. The sinking of these two ships led to the setting of the stage for the Japanese to occupy Malaya. This Pulau Redang Island is ideal for a number of activities such as snorkelling, swimming, scuba-diving, jungle trekking, boating and canoeing. Fishing is not allowed within a 3.2km radius of the island since Pulau Redang is gazetted as a marine park. The collection of corals and other aquatic life is also strictly prohibited.

SEA BREEZE OF PANGKOR ISLAND

Pangkor Island ,welcomes visitors with its serene, golden beaches, crystalline blue water and cool, refreshing breezes. Located about 90km south west of Ipoh, it is largely inhabited by fisherfolk. They live in scattered fishing settlements along the coast especially on the eastern side, facing the town of Lumut and Teluk Batik, and their catch comprises mainly cuttlefish and anchovy. The modern facilities make it an ideal gateway. A wide range of sun and sea activities are available such as scuba diving, wind-surfing, fishing, snorkelling. Along the west coast of Peninsula Malaysia, there is only one island that can boast of its beaches being the best. Of course there are a couple of small isolated islands of Langkawai that has really nice beaches. These are short stretches and difficult to access. It has being kept "nice" due to the fact that such places see little traffic. The beaches in Pangkor with large crowd can no longer lay claim to such fact. Their quality of beaches varied from good to mediocre. For example, that at Pasir Bogak is marginally better than those in Penang or Langkawai. Then a couple of less trodden beaches can be rated as good. This scene was taken at a place towards the end of the beach in Pasir Bogak. The main area filled with crowd and the street busy coping up with the endless line of traffic! It was better to skip such scene so as not to deter you!

Auckland Art Gallery – Toi o Tamaki

- Heralded in 1888 as 'the first permanent Art Gallery in the Dominion', Auckland Art Gallery Toi o Tamaki remains the largest art institution in New Zealand, with a collection now numbering over 15,000 works
