Betawi's Urban Culture

Urbanization has made Jakarta more crowded, with new residents locals or otherwise seeking a better place to live in since the days of the country's independence.

In that flow of time, the natives of Jakarta , known as Betawi are struggling to preserve their own local culture and identity to stay alive on the land of their ancestors. Elements of Betawi traditional culture, such as ondel-ondel, tanjidor and gambang kromong are becoming rare in Jakarta. Once a year, Jakarta's residents get to see these during Jakarta's anniversary celebration, but the performances can hardly be found throughout the rest of the year. They perform lenong on request and during Jakarta's anniversary celebrations.

Traditional music including tanjidor and gambang kromong are also performed by the group's members. Tanjidor is usually performed during Betawi wedding celebrations and the gambang kromong orchestra is performed to accompany the giant ondel-ondel puppet dance.

The gambang kromong orchestra consists of instruments such as suling (Betawi traditional flute), percussion including the gong, gendang, kecrek and string instruments such as sukong, tehyan and kohyan. Many gambang kromong orchestras played more modern Betawi songs, including those created by the late Betawi artist Benyamin S.. Traditional songs such as "Centeng Manis", "Stambul Rusak" and "Jali-Jali" are more difficult to play and sing because of their intricate musical twists.

The importance of religion and pencak silat practice in preserving Betawi culture are intertwined. In fact the Islamic ritual of "ngaji" [Koran reading] and pencak silat are fundamental to Betawi culture as they serve as a means to manage our mind and emotions. Interestingly, humor can't be eliminated from Betawi culture. Betawi people are famed for being hospitable and humorous and they are known to infuse humor into their daily conversation. It is almost like the local way of mingling and to surviving life's stresses. In order to preserve and develop Betawi art and culture, there are requests for the city's government to build more Betawi cultural centers and performance buildings.

The Betawi culture proponents lack many places to perform other than at Setu Babakan, Sawangan. Televisions and large theatre buildings require them to pay to perform, therefore it was no surprise when smaller Betawi cultural groups choose to perform on the street or collect money door-to-door as can be seen on the streets of Jakarta on a daily basis.

The people are hoping that more Betawi cultural centers can be built in Jakarta and that the Betawi cultural groups such as Si Pitung can perform more often, hopefully reviving Betawi culture even more.

By doing so, hopefully Jakartans will not have to wait until June to see the Betawi perform, and younger generations will get to learn about Betawi culture through experiences, not only by reading about it in school textbooks.



From the twice-annual Fashion Week to April's annual Salone del Mobile(Furniture Fair), Milan is where you will find cutting-edge fashion, furniture and industrial design. Prada, Valentino, Gucci: all the great Italian couture houses have multiple shops lining the elegant streets of the Quadrilatero d'Oro (Golden Quad) and in the Neo-Classical, glass-domed Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II. "Even though Milan isn't the most beautiful of Italian cities, there's a lot to love." said Sara Schifano, a native Milanese arts writer. "You get to live and work at a stimulating rhythm, although it never becomes too stressful. And the city transforms itself during fashion and design weeks, but quickly goes back to its pace when they're over."

That pace might already be considered faster than the rest of the country, since Milan is home to the Borsa Italiana, Italy's stock market, its banking and publishing sectors, and two of international football's top teams: AC Milan and Inter. The city will host the sustainability- and food-themed Expo 2015 in Rho Pero, a former industrial area northwest of the city, adjacent to a high-speed rail link.

Even with towers designed by architects Zaha Hadid and Cesar Pelli, the white Gothic spires of the Duomo still dominate the heart of the city, and landmarks like the Teatro alla Scala and Leonardo da Vinci's fresco masterpiece, The Last Supper, are the foundation of the city's deep cultural heritage.

Side trips

The Italian Lake District is just 45 minutes north of Milan by train, so strolling around Lake Como or Lake Garda is an easy day trip for the Milanese. In the summer, many residents head to holiday homes and resorts along the Ligurian coast about 125km to the south, while in winter, locals flock to ski resorts in , about 175km northwest of the city.

High-speed rail links Milan to other major Italian cities; it takes one hour and 40 minutes to reach Florence and just under three hours to get to Rome. The largest of Milan's three airports, Malpensa Airport, has flights to European and international destinations. A flight to London is less than two hours, as is Catania in Sicily; New York is more than eight hours away. "Milan is in a great location, it's as easy to go for a weekend in Sicily as it is to London or Paris," Schifano said.



The city is located on the Coromandel Coast of the Bay of Bengal. The British developed the city into a major urban centre along with a strong naval base in the 17th century. By the 20th century, it became an important administrative centre.

Chennai, rightly known as an exotic state, is famous for its cutworks in the temples, coconut fringes, and silk sarees. This 350 year old city is surrounded by the green environment and gifted by the rich traditional charm of art and culture. In 1639, the British took over the place and made it the capital of the British presidency. It used to be the centre of conflict for the supremacy of the British and the French. In 1612 the Dutch East India Company built a settlement in Pulicat further north.

Chennai is divided into North, South, Central and West parts. The North side is primarily an industrial area whereas the Central part is the commercial heart of the city which also includes Parry's Corner, an important business district. Comparatively, South Chennai and West Chennai used to be residential areas. Though, now they are becoming commercial regions with many information technology firms, financial companies and call centres.

The Guindy National Park is one of the few parks which are lodged up within the limit of the city. Chennai is one of the few cities in the world that accommodates a national park, within its limits. Today, the city is developing rapidly and has become a fast growing city in India. Currently there are many major industries in the field like automobile, Hardware manufacture, technology, health and education. It is ranked as a second major exporter of IT and is also well-known as the automobile capital of India.

Beside these major industries, it is also top in sports and includes a number of stadiums in order to promote it. Chennai is blessed with art and literature so it is also famous for its Film Industry known as 'Kollywood'. It is the main centre fir film of Tamil Nadu so there is a major impact of movie stars and their role in society. 
Seminar Produk Pelancongan Kelantan Renaissance Kota Bharu Wednesday , 26 March 2014
